Questions:

- 1. Asaph (in Psalm 73) had become deeply bitter about apparent injustices in life. Have you ever found yourself in a similar place?
- 2. Review the main points of the sermon together. What stood out to you? Do you have any questions to bring up?
- 3. Which of the blessings listed in the outline (Perspective, Security, Hope, and Communion) do you need the most of in your life right now?
- 4. How did Asaph end up experiencing these blessings? In what practical ways can we follow his example?
- 5. Read Psalm 42:1-6
 - a) Why do you think this psalm writer might have been feeling discouraged?
 - b) What images does he use to describe his longing for God?
 - c) How does he counter his depression?
 - d) How can we follow the psalm writer's example in dealing with our doubts and depression?
 - e) What memories of God's work in your own life tend to bring you encouragement?
 - f) What methods can you use to remind yourself to turn to the Lord with your problems instead of allowing them to anger or frustrate you? Discuss some ideas.
- 6. If you need your heart renewed in some area, share it with your group.
- 7. Spend some time praying for each other. Invite the Lord to bring renewal to your hearts. Let the Holy Spirit work to bring healing.
